## **Information Items:**

Additional valve requests - neighbors continue to request the removal of valve or movement of valve to front yards. The district does not permit valve removal but an additional valve, paid by the homeowner can be completed. A form, which can be downloaded from the district website is required for approval and the cost of the additional valve is by the homeowner.

Water flood and overflows - While the District continues to maintain and repair the system we must emphasize it is important to highlight the responsibilities of each homeowner. State law (ARS 45-112) requires each of us to restrict irrigation to our properties without overflow into the public right-of-ways. The board has created a new form letter to notify the homeowner if an overflow/flood has been identified requiring repair. The repair should be completed by the next irrigation run to ensure delivery of irrigation to the property be maintained.
